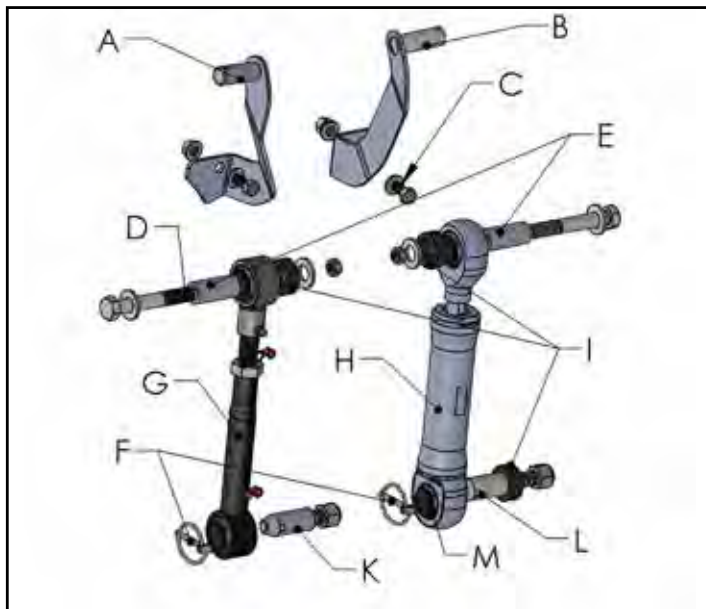

NOT COMPATIBLE WITH aftermarket swaybars.
Install product with Original Equipment swaybar only.

NEVER DISCONNECT swaybar when operating vehicle on public roads.

WHEN DISCONNECTED, the sway bar must be secured to the chassis in a relatively horizontal position by the retention brackets provided, lanyards, or other means. Failure to do so could cause interference with the tires or other components.

WARNING

Stay Connected On-Road

WARNING

To assure intended performance JKS® Quicker Disconnects™ are NOT COMPATIBLE with aftermarket Swaybars. Install ONLY with Jeep® factory sway bar.

Installation

1. REMOVE ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT (OE) SWAYBAR LINKS

- Remove front swaybar links and save lower mounting hardware (18mm).



2. INSTALL FLEX CONNECT SWAY BAR DISCONNECT SYSTEM TO SWAY BAR

- adjust the link to 9 7/16".

11-5/8" max. length

CAUTION

Max. length is based on required thread engagement. Measure & DO NOT extend Quicker Disconnects™ beyond maximum length of your part number.

- Once adjusted, tighten jam nuts firmly against the lower ends .

IMPORTANT: Bushing cradles at both ends of disconnect must remain parallel with each other when Jam Nut is tightened.

- For adjustment of the Flex Connect link please see the "Flex Connect Rebuild" section at the end of the instruction.
- Insert the longer sleeves into the upper bushing (male end) and slide the polyurethane spacer onto the upper sleeve so it will mount towards the swaybar. The links will be installed with the grease fittings forward.
- Using the provided 12mm x 75mm bolts, loosely fasten the sway bar links to the sway bar with the bolts installed from the outside towards the frame.



- Measure back 1-1/4" from the center of the sway bar link hole or just past the weld at the axle and make a vertical cut line. Cut off the tab at the mark and paint exposed metal.



- Attach the short mounting post into the original sway bar link mount hole on the track bar bracket. Tighten the post ensuring the click pin hole is horizontal or parallel with the ground. Tighten to 65 ft-lbs.

Note: A small screwdriver or punch inserted into the pin hole will keep the post from turning as you tighten it.



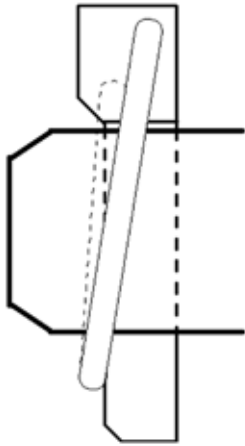
- Attach the long mounting post with polyurethane spacer into the factory sway bar link mount. The stud should point towards the center of the vehicle. Tighten the post ensuring the click pin hole is horizontal or parallel with the ground. Tighten to 65 ft-lbs.



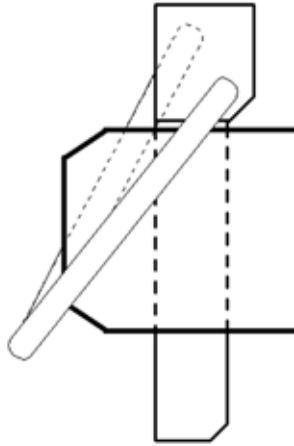
❑ 3. INSTALL FLEX CONNECT SWAY BAR DISCONNECT SYSTEM

- Torque the Flex Connect to sway bar mounting bolts to 65 ft-lbs.
- Insert click pins as illustrated to secure.

CORRECT



WRONG



When properly installed, the ring on the Click Pin will “snap” against the shaft of pin. When installed backwards, the ring does not fit snugly against shaft.



❑ 4. INSTALL FLEX CONNECT SWAY BAR DISCONNECT SYSTEM RETENTION BRACKETS

- Install the retention brackets using the provided 5/16” bolts into the factory hole in the front of the coil bucket as shown. These are designed to slightly form to the edge of the coil bucket to hold them in place.



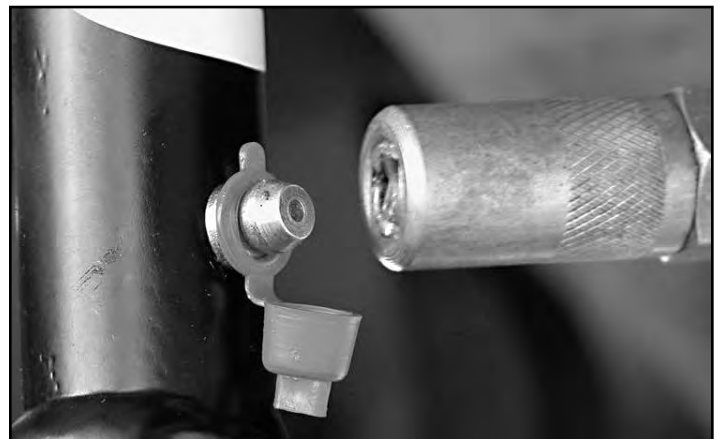
- With the vehicle at ride height, slide the ends of the disconnects on to the axle posts. Insert click pins to secure.
- Torque the flex connect to sway bar mounting bolts to 65 ft-lbs.

⚠ CAUTION

When disconnected with the retention brackets, adequate bump stop must be in place to prevent sway bar to steering interference under extreme conditions. In most cases the lift system should have adequate bump to ensure clearance. If adequate bump stop is not present, a lanyard kit may be required instead of the retention brackets.

❑ 5. LUBRICATE QUICKER DISCONNECTS

- Lubricate all grease zerk fittings on the Quicker Disconnects immediately after installation using common wheel bearing grease or equivalent.

❑ 6. CORRECT OPERATION OF DISCONNECTING THE FLEX CONNECT

- Remove the click pins from the axle and slide the disconnects off of the axle posts.
- Rotate the quicker disconnect up until they fit onto the retention bracket. The sway bar may need to be rotated to get them in place.
- Reattached the click pins to the retention brackets to hold them in place.
- To reconnect, remove click pins from retention brackets and slide the links down to the axle.
- Slide quicker disconnects back onto the mounting posts and re-install click pins.

Troubleshooting

If swaybar does not rotate freely enough, remove from vehicle, clean and apply rubber lubricant to chassis-mounted bushings, and reinstall.

Maintenance

It is important to lubricate Flex Connects frequently for the first three (3) months after installation to evacuate contaminants that may build up during break-in period.

After break-in period, Flex Connects should be lubricated regularly as part of vehicle maintenance schedule.

Regular cleaning with pressurized water is recommended to maximize ease of operation and reliability. Always lubricate afterwards to evacuate any moisture.

The internal components of the Flex Connect are sealed and designed for maintenance free long term performance. These instructions are provided as a reference for the steps required to swap springs. The Flex Connect Performance Spring Kit is sold separately as part number 2100.

❑ 1. FLEX CONNECT DISASSEMBLY

These instructions are written with the assumption the customer has the assembly wrenches included in the Performance Spring Kit. If not, 2 crescent wrenches with jaw openings up to 1-1/2" can be used.

- Hold the body of the Flex Connect across the flats and loosen the Flex Connect body as shown in the Figure.

Note: A 3/8" ratchet can be inserted into the square hole in the wrench if additional leverage is required.



Note: If using a vice, put the cap in the vice jaws and use the provided wrench on the body to prevent the vice from binding on the threads.

- With the cap unthreaded, slide the shaft assembly out of the body.
- Tip the Flex Connect body up and the spring followed by the washer will fall out of the body.
- To remove the spring from the shaft, hold the shaft across the flats next to the bronze bushing and remove the nut.

Note: The wrench with the rounded opening is 1/2" across the flats for the rod and the other is 9/16" for the nut.



- Slide the spring off of the shaft.

Note: The spring washer goes on the side of the spring towards the cap.

□ 2. FLEX CONNECT ASSEMBLY

- Install the washer back into the body of the Flex Connect followed by the spring of your choosing.

Effective Spring Rates - % softer than stock sway bar	
Blue Spring	80%
Yellow Spring	65%
Red Spring	50%
Flex Connect OE Spring	40%

- Install a matching spring onto the Flex Connect shaft followed by the bronze bushing and nut
- Torque the nut to 25 ft-lbs.

IMPORTANT: Always install matching springs into the Flex Connect. Failure to do so will create different roll stiffness depending on the direction of roll and yield undesirable handling characteristics.



- Apply grease to the bronze bushing if it was removed during disassembly
- Slide the Flex Connect shaft back into the housing and slide the cap down the shaft until the threads engage.
- Tighten the cap to approximately 25 ft-lbs.
